Basciano Rosato di Toscana 2019

Fattoria di Basciano is the estate owned by the Masi family since the beginning of 1900. It is located right in the heart of the Chianti Rufina area. The 2019 Basciano Rosato di Toscana is a fresh and eye-catching Italian Rosé wine made from 100% Sangiovese grapes. The wine is fresh fruity with marked floral perfumes and nevertheless concentrated and consistent.

Radley & Finch Chenin Blanc 2018

The name was inspired from the famous book: To Kill a Mockingbird, but unlike the serious nature of the book, these wines aim to reflect a typical and light-hearted style of wine true to the most enjoyed grape varieties originating in South Africa. A good example of why Chenin has for a long time been the workhorse and favorite in South Africa but is now starting to be recognized all over for its versatility and brilliantly defined fruit flavors. The 2018 medium in body with floral notes combined with peach candy and a mélange of ripe, juicy stone fruits on the nose. Fresh and lively on the palate with bright acidity and fruit that echoes the nose (but not quite as ripe), along with lingering minerality on the finish.

I FAVATI Fiano di Avellino Pietramara

The I Favati winery represents the culmination of a tradition dating back to the early 1900's, when the family's ancestors began making wine in the traditional way for their own table and for a few close friends. The passion and artisanal traditions of those ancestors continue to thrive today. Fiano di Avellino is dry white wine with immense purity of fruit and refinement which places it in the top rank of all Italian white wines. The 2017 Pietramara is an elegant pale yellow in color, fresh and minerally, slightly smoky with notes of lemon peel and pear. Medium body, excellent fruit, long finish carries a note of grilled pineapple and dried fruits.

Raeburn Russian River Valley Chardonnay 2018

Raeburn Winery, located in the scenic Russian River Valley, was created by Derek Benham in 2014. The winery is one of the most eco-friendly, water-efficient, solar-enabled facilities in the industry. Their goal is to protect the thriving and wildly diverse watersheds of Sonoma County and beyond, which provide habitat for both grapes and creatures alike. The 2018 Russian RRV Chardonnay is a nod to classic California Chardonnay - elegant and expressive with intense fruit character, layers of green apple and pear with creaminess and toasty vanilla.

Murrieta's Well Whip White 2017

Fermented and aged in a combination of stainless steel and neutral barrels, this wine displays full-bodied aromas and flavors of white peach, vanilla, butterscotch and orange blossom with an extended and balanced finish. 35% Sauvignon Blanc, 31% Semillon, 15% Orange Muscat, 11% Chardonnay, 6% Viognier, 2% Muscat Canelli

Les Hauts de Lagarde Bordeaux 2018

The Les Hauts de Lagarde Rouge 2018 is a certified Organic blend of 65% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 10% Cabernet Franc grown and produced at the Vignobles Raymond (Vineyards of Raymond) Estate near the town of Saint Laurent du Bois, in the Entre-Deux-Mers region of Bordeaux, France. The Estate is family owned and was founded in 1850. The fruitiness, roundness and tannic mouth gives the wine a rare elegance. A harmonious wine. This wine reveals great aromas of blackcurrant, blackberries and spices. Beautiful crimson robe with intense purple reflections.

Masi Campofiorin 2016

Campofiorin is the original "Supervenetian," made with Masi's double fermentation technique. A specialty wine, this red is made from local Veronese grapes Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara vinified and then re-fermented with a small percentage of semi-dried grapes of the same varieties. Ruby-red in color with violet traces; the wine shows generous, ripe aromas of plum and cherry jam, with hints of spice. Bold and rich flavors of bitter cherries and berry fruits stand out on the palate, with good acidity, balance and velvety tannins. This very versatile wine is perfect with many different foods.

Sean Minor Pinot Noir 2018

Sean Minor's wine making philosophy is to offer wines that exude quality and truly represent the appellation, from which they're produced, yet are affordable for everyday enjoyment. The 2018 California Pinot Noir is a medium bodied wine which displays aromas of floral components, red fruit and dark cherries. On the palate, the Pinot offers luscious flavors of dark cherry, strawberry and violets, combined with subtle layers of spice. The integrated bright acidity and oak nuances provide a lingering finish. A well balanced, solid wine that goes with a variety of foods!

Educated Guess Napa County Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

Proprietor Mark Albrecht philosophy is that great wines can be affordable and Roots Run Deep Winery is dedicated to producing wines that can compete with \$50-\$100 wines for a fraction of the price. The 2017 Educated Guess Napa County Cabernet is a sumptuous, lush, and full-bodied wine, with flavors of juicy blackberry and cherry fruit, creamy like milk chocolate, and dusty notes all tied together with a toasty oak finish that is lingering.

Donati Claret 2016

Blend: 43% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot, 7% Malbec, 5% Cabernet Franc, 3% Petit Verdot. Aromas of cherry cola. The palate is well balanced, medium bodied with well integrated tannins. There are notes of blackberry, mocha and boysenberry on the palate.

The finish has lingering notes of mocha and graphite as well as candied cherry.

Orin Swift Cellars Machete 2015

Petit Sirah, Grenache, and Syrah. The grapes are sourced from Napa, Sonoma, and Mendocino counties. This wine was bottled with 12 different labels. A brooding hue and viscous consistency, powerful aromas of crème de cassis, boysenberry, and ripe cherries are complemented by a soft minerality and hints of dark chocolate. The entry is smooth with dark plums and a charred meatiness that floods to create a velvety texture that lingers.
