Gruener Veltliner

The nose is fruity with pretty floral notes and hints of herbal scents. On the palate, this Austrian wine has crisp acidity, rich fruits, citrus and gooseberry



Rkatsiteli

Full of grassy, grapefruit-driven fruit with spicy notes, strawberries, and a bit of white pepper. Long and graceful finish.



Blaufrankisch

Light ruby, with some blueberry and spice on the nose. The palate is fresh, with dark ripe cherries, blueberries, and a velvety finish. Fine tannins, well integrated acidity and good length.



Cabernet Franc

Blackberry, raisin, prune and apricot aromas that lengthen with oaky and spicy tones. On the palate, this wine displays great elegance with good acidity, moderate tannins and bright berry fruit.
