NAOMI SPARKLING RIESLING

“Naomi”, a name that has run in the Hosmer family for some time, is said to mean ‘pleasantness’. A fitting word to describe this fun, bubbly, force carbonated Riesling. The nose of this Riesling brings forward rich mandarin and raspberry along with well-balanced carbonation.

The finish is filled with hints of lemon zest and cherry blossom.

TORRES VERDEO

100% Verdejo wine, an attractive pale yellow colour with green tinges. Very fragrant with floral notes of lemon balm and exquisite undertones reminiscent of passion fruit. Silky and intense on the palate with lively fruit acidity and a spicy vegetative note characteristic of the variety.

RUFFINO ORVIETO

This wine’s smooth, refreshing flavors balance beautifully with its structure and acidity. Orvieto also offers a unique mineral character that comes from the chalky limestone soil called tufa. The finish is long and fragrant, with hints of almond. Grechetto 40%, Procanico

20%, other white varietals (Verdello, Canaiolo Bianco) 40%

TERRA D’ORO CHENIN BLANC VIOGNIER

Terra d’Oro Chenin Blanc & Viognier displays luring aromas of juicy tropical fruits, fresh lemon and hints of spice. The palate boasts flavors of pink grapefruit, papaya, and subtle sweet mango. This wine is lively, refreshing and well balanced with crisp acidity – perfect for a warm afternoon or during sunset hour
